### Students invited to participate in Earth Fair

**Goodells, MI** – The St. Clair County Earth Fair Committee is now accepting reservations for field trips to the 2010 Earth Fair for students in 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grades.

The St. Clair County 8<sup>th</sup> annual Earth Fair will be held at Goodells County Park on Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and on Saturday, April 17<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Admission is free.

Teachers with 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms are invited to sign up for a field trip to Earth Fair. Earth Fair is a tool teachers can use to augment science lessons taught in the classroom and enables students to interact with ‘field experts’ in a hands-on learning environment. Some topics covered include clean water, wetland importance, animal rehabilitation, energy conservation, sustainability, land preservation, recycling, gardening, and pollution prevention.

The Earth Fair Committee is also accepting registrations for exhibitors to the Fair. Exhibitors may be a for-profit, non-profit, individual, youth club, school, or agency has a message, cause, product or service that addresses the environment.

The St. Clair County Environmental Education Network was developed in May 2002 and consists of County and local agencies, and nonprofit groups committed to environmental education in St. Clair County.
