Earth Fair Volunteer Guidelines

- Dress warm! Even though it is spring, it can be pretty cool and windy inside the Exhibit Barns. Bring along or dress in warm clothes, hats, gloves, and winter coat in case it is needed. You'll be glad to have it!
- There will be several vendors serving good food during the event, but they might not have what you want, so bring something to snack on.
- Please plan to eat either before or after your volunteer shift, not during. You will be provided with a "free lunch voucher" for your shift.
- Please arrive for your shift 15 minutes early. This is when you will be briefed on your volunteer duties. This also allows the volunteer before you to leave on-time.
- If you would like to browse the Earth Fair booths, please plan to come early or stay late, and not browse during your volunteer shift. There will be many vendors selling great products so you may want to bring along some money. Many items can be purchased ranging in price from \$1 - \$50.
- There will be free water available to you during your shift. Please bring a thermos or bottle to refill throughout your shift.
