

expansive, branched stem and root system.

Conifers A bush or tree (such as a pine) that produces cones and usually has needles that are green all year.

Deciduous A bush or tree that has leaves that fall off every year.

Pollinators Some fruit trees and vegetable plants need a pollination partner (different variety) to bear produce. Planting the

appropriate species will help ensure a great crop.

Urban Areas \* Some trees are not suitable for small lots, road right of ways, urban parcels with sidewalks or underground utilities
